

Recovery At A Glance– Douglas County Nov. 16, 2020

(As of Nov. 15, 2020, unless otherwise noted)

- Eighty individuals and households have been approved for \$543,744 in federal grants through FEMA's Individuals and Households Program.
- \$381,000 in U.S. Small Business Administration low-interest disaster loans have been approved for 5 homeowners and renters as of Nov. 13.

Housing Assistance:

- There have been approximately \$406,552 in grants approved for housing repairs or replacement for 59 homeowners.
- \$137,192 in grants have been approved for personal property, transportation and other disaster-related serious needs for 64 applicants.
- 1,552 home inspections have been issued with 99 percent completed.

Outreach to Survivors:

- The External Outreach Site at Old Middle School Gym, 301 Glide Loop Rd. Glide, OR 97443, closed Nov. 14 and assisted 47 visitors.
- There have been 12 Speaker's Bureau events, providing information regarding FEMA programs throughout disaster-affected communities.
- Through Disaster Survivor Assistance (DSA) field outreach, 80 survivors were referred to disaster resources and recovery partners for needs beyond what FEMA can provide as of Nov 9.
- Through DSA virtual outreach, at least 42,538 people were reached via 92 organizations and non-congregate shelters willing to disseminate disaster assistance information aka, DSA Distro Packet as of Nov 9.
