**INDOOR MASK MANDATE ENDS MARCH 12!** Governor Kate Brown [announced yesterday](#) that the state's indoor mask mandate for employers and public spaces will end March. 12.

The Governor made the announcement in concert with Washington and California. The joint press release attributed the three-state shift to falling case rates and hospitalizations. Though the mandate will end March 12, the state's permanent COVID rule governing workplaces, adopted in

December, remains in effect. Business organizations throughout the state have urged the state to repeal this rule since there is no longer a need.

Yesterday's announcement does not apply to mandates in health-care settings or public transportation. Meanwhile, employers may adopt their own mask requirements to protect employees and customers.
