VOTE for Business in County Commissioner Races

Roseburg Area Chamber Endorses Proven Pro-Business Incumbents

At its January meeting, the Roseburg Area Chamber of Commerce board of directors voted unanimously to endorse all three incumbent Douglas County commissioners in their re-election bids this May.







The chamber's endorsements of Commissioner Tom Kress (position 1), Commissioner Tim Freeman (position 2) and Commissioner Chris Boice (position 3) are based on board-established criteria which, first and foremost, recognizes that these distinguished public servants have earned and maintained the chamber's confidence by their individual, and unified, support of Douglas County businesses.

Chamber endorsement criteria considers a candidate's campaign platform and electability, But, greatest weight is given to the voting record/track record as an elected official, and active participation with the Roseburg Area Chamber including a willingness to engage with and maintain a positive working relationship with chamber leadership for the benefit of Douglas County businesses.

The Roseburg Area Chamber is greatly appreciative for the pro-business work, especially on behalf of small business, by of our county commissioners. Their willingness to work with the chamber, be available and take the initiative to reach out to staff and leadership has proven beneficial to local businesses. Defending Local Business

Roseburg Area Chamber Advocating Business Interests in Salem

The Roseburg Area Chamber has weighed in on several House and Senate bills during the 2022 Oregon Legislative Session, and has been monitoring about 30-35 more. The Oregon Legislature's 2022 "short session" began on February 1, running for about six weeks, with an end date of no later than March 7.

The chamber utilized its **2021-22 Public Affairs & Legislative Agenda** and long list of past and ongoing positions to determine what proposed legislation it will either oppose or support. Noted positions, include:

Opposing HB 4018--An auto-insurance bill resulting in increased cost for nearly 60% of

Oregon drivers and adversely impacting business. Billed died in committee.

Opposing HB 4002A--Relating to changing current overtime rules for ag and farm workers,

adversely impacting small rural farms and, ultimately workers.

Supporting SB 1501 and 1502--Related to the Oregon's Private Forest Accord.

The chamber also sent a letter to legislators and the Governor asking Oregon leadership to oppose proposed Washington State legislation to impose an "export fuel" tax, a gas tax costing Oregon drivers six cents a gallon.

The chamber encourages our members to utilize the Oregon Legislative Information System or OLIS for current information about and status of proposed legislation during Oregon Legislative session.

February 18: Deadline to Post Work Session (second chamber) √

February 24: Deadline for Committees to Hold Work Session on Second Chamber Measures $\sqrt{}$

March 7: Last Possible Legislative Day

March 8: Filing Day
