Questions About Oregon's New Paid Leave Insurance?

Raise Your Hand . . . at the November Membership Lunch

Oregon's new paid family and medical leave insurance program is about to begin. Employers and employees will begin paying into the program on January 1, 2023. On September 3, 2023, employees can begin to apply for benefits. What businesses are required to participate in the new program? What are small employer responsibilities? What is an equivalent plan? Do employees have to participate? These questions and more will be answered at the chamber's November 14 membership lunch program "Paid Leave Oregon" presented by Phillip Hudspeth, Outreach Program Analyst with the Oregon Employment Department.

Expert Panel to Discuss Current and Future Economic Expectations

On November 14 the chamber's Economic Forecast 2023 program will take a look at the past year and the economic impacts on our local businesses, our county and our state. Our presenters will explore current events and issues; the political climate; local industries having significant economic impact; and, share valuable information about trends to help members strategically plan for 2023.

This year's panel will address the results and anticipated impacts of the statewide and national mid-term elections. Industry experts will delve into the timber and wood products industry, real estate trends, ongoing workforce shortages and more. Addressing the overall economy will be John Tapogna, Economist, ECONorthwest. Joining Tapogna, will be Travis Joseph, Oregon Forest Resource Council; Jeremy Rogers, Oregon Association of Realtors; and, John Horvick, DHM Research.

Roseburg Area Chamber Endorses Three in Oregon House Races

The Roseburg Area Chamber of Commerce board of directors voted unanimously to endorse the following incumbents/candidate seeking election to Oregon's House of Representatives in this November's general election.

Candidate Virgle Osborne

The chamber endorsed the honorable David Brock Smith, incumbent, in his reelection bid to Oregon House District 1 and the honorable Christine Goodwin, incumbent House District 2, in her campaign for the Oregon House District 4 seat. These endorsements are, first and foremost, because these distinguished public servants have earned and maintained the chamber's confidence by their support of Douglas County businesses during their service in the Oregon Legislature.

The chamber considers a number of criteria when endorsing incumbents, with the greatest weight given to the legislator's voting record and active engagement with the Roseburg Area Chamber and Douglas County business community.

To round out its legislative endorsements, the chamber is supporting local business owner and candidate for Oregon House District 2, Virgle Osborne. The chamber's government affairs team (GAT) managed the chamber's formal candidate review/interview process, recommending Osborne's endorsement to the board. The board's endorsement of Osborne reflects the alignment of his campaign platform with the chamber's pro-business initiatives and advocacy positions.

All three of these endorsements are also reflective of board criteria related to electability, candidates existing relationships with local businesses and business organizations and a willingness to maintain a positive working relationship with chamber leadership.

The Roseburg Area Chamber looks forward to working with these members of our Oregon House delegation during the 2023 legislative session and beyond, on behalf of our local businesses.
