Chamber Files Amicus Curiae Briefs with U.S. Supreme Court

In case you missed it, on December 14, the Roseburg Area Chamber of Commerce filed a Brief of *Amici Curiae* in support of petition for certiorari filed by petitioners in *Murphy Company, et al v. Joseph R. Biden, Jr., in his official capacity as President of the United States, et al.* On Friday, December 15, the Roseburg Area Chamber of Commerce filed a Brief of *Amici Curiae* in support of petition for certiorari filed by petitioners in *American Forest Resource Council, et al v. United States of America, et al.*

Amicus curiae literally means "friend of the court;" an individual or organization that is not a party to a particular case, but which has interest in the case or information related to a case of critical importance to their community(ies). The chamber's filings are founded in its long-standing interested and advocation for active management of public forestland for all designated purposes mandated under the O & C Act of 1937. The chamber was pleased to have NFIB (National Federation of Independent Business) Small Business Legal Center join both briefs in support of the U.S. Supreme Court petitions. <u>Read joint press statement</u>.
